- All of Cut Bank Public Schools collectively and individually qualified for Universal support which is the highest designation available in ESSA.
- Cut Bank Middle and Elementary Schools (HC Davis, Anna Jeffries, and Cut Bank Middle School) tested at 72% proficient and advanced in Science.

An area for improvement and call to action,

- Attendance among some of our sup-groups is holding back student success. We will be looking for methods by which we can improve attendance and test scores.
- Cut Bank Schools are working on improvement in reading and math from grades K-12.
- Cut Bank Middle School and High School will have new math textbooks for next school year, and the new textbooks are aligned with the common core curriculum.

Local data to share,

- Cut Bank Schools place more emphasis on our localized assessments, and our students are consistently demonstrating growth in our assessments given in fall and spring.
